Founded in 1582, it was considered one of the best medical schools in Europe by the eighteenth century.

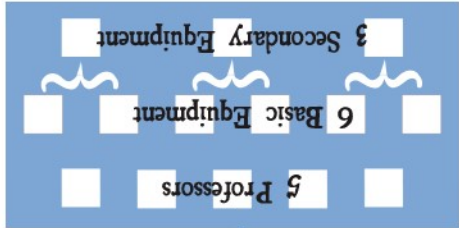

The university was founded in 1343. It went through ups and downs when it was conquered by Florence but then regained its influence and reputation.

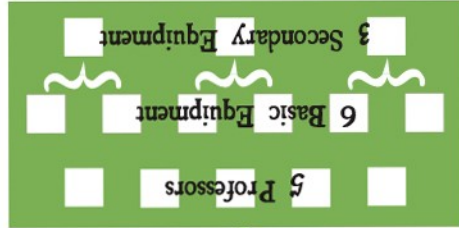
